

# Singapore's First Award to recognise organisations that support fathers in the workplace open for nominations

Singapore, 28 September 2022 – Nominations for the Great Companies for Dads Awards 2023 is open! Companies which encourage work-life harmony with family-centric policies that support fathers are invited to submit nominations.

Into its second edition, the Great Companies for Dads Awards motivate organisations to continually help their employees, especially Dads, achieve balance between work and family.

The Great Companies for Dads Awards 2023 will be presented to more than 10 deserving organisations by Guest of Honour, President Halimah Yacob, at the Centre for Fathering's Charity Ball on 10 February 2023.

Award winners will be judged based on the following criteria:

- Demonstration of innovative policies on parental and paternity leave that go beyond stipulated legislation;
- Demonstration of policies benefitting Dads such as shared parenting initiatives, flexible work arrangements and Dads support network and resources; and
- Adoption of Centre for Fathering, DADs for Life and Families for Life initiatives and programmes such as Eat With Your Family Day and parenting workshops.

Mr Bryan Tan, CEO, Centre for Fathering, DADs for Life and MUMs for Life said, said, "Employers play a critical role in supporting fathers to strengthen families for Singapore. Employees who are wellsupported by their organisations in work-life integration are able to juggle their roles at work and family more effectively, knowing that their personal lives are also looked after by the company. Companies will also benefit from greater productivity and employee engagement and have lower employee turnover."

"Championing family-friendly workplaces and culture is one of the themes for the Year of Celebrating SG Families. This spotlights the pivotal role of employers in nurturing a conducive work environment that can support their employees' family and career aspirations. Through My Family Weekend campaign that Families for Life initiated in 2017, we have seen more employers adopting flexible-work arrangements over the years. We hope that the Awards will encourage the employers to entrench family-friendly practices post pandemic and inspire more to do so." shared Families for Life Council Chairman, Mr Ishak Ismail.

Mr Tan further added, "As such, it is important for companies to provide and embrace initiatives such as additional childcare leave, flexible work arrangements, parenting programmes and participate in the nation-wide Eat With Your Family Day initiative to nurture a family-friendly work culture. The Great Companies for Dads Awards motivate organisations to continually help their employees, especially Dads, achieve a great balance between work and family."

Launched in 2021, the Great Companies for Dads Awards is Singapore's first award to recognise outstanding organisations with policies and practices that support fathers in the workplace to strengthen families for Singapore. It is organised by Centre for Fathering, DADs for Life and MUMs for Life, in partnership with Families for Life and in support of Made For Families and Celebrating SG Families. During the inaugural Great Companies for Dads Awards in 2021, five organisations from the public and private sectors were selected as winners. They are City Developments Limited, Ministry of Defence/Singapore Armed Forces (MINDEF/SAF), Michelman Asia-Pacific Pte Ltd, Ministry of Social and Family Development and Singapore Management University. In addition, another eight companies received letters of commendation for their efforts in encouraging work-life integration.

Centre for Fathering (CFF) is a non-profit organisation founded in 2000 to promote active and involved fathering and address issues caused by fatherlessness in Singapore.
